General Rules:

1. All dogs must be on a leash
2. All dogs must provide proof of current vaccinations
3. All dogs must be of at least 4 months of age or older
4. Dogs should be on their best behavior (no fighting, biting or aggressiveness). Lilac Festival organizers reserves the right to disqualify any participant whose pet is showing aggression to humans or other animals.
5. Must be a certified Wiener Dog—this does not mean they have to be AKC registered. If the shot record from the vet indicates breed of dog as dachshund, then it is a wiener dog.
6. Owners are required to clean up their dog's accidents (use plastic waste bags).
7. Festival Organizers are NOT RESPONSIBLE for dog bites.

Race Rules:

1. Each dog requires a two person team to race: the Releaser (at the start line) and the Catcher (at the finish line). Catcher & Releaser must be 18 or older or accompanied by a parent or guardian. You must have a Catcher and Releaser to participate.
2. Dogs must remain on a leash until time to race.
3. Racing distance will be between 30-50 feet.
4. People are not allowed in the racing lanes. The dogs only run from start to finish.
5. The Catcher may use various means to entice their dogs to the finish line—favorite toy, food, etc. Nothing can be rolled or thrown in the racing lane. (i.e., releaser may not roll a ball down the lane for the dog to chase)
6. Races are run in heats of 5-6 dogs. Winner of each heat advances to the next race.
7. All pre-registered dogs will be entered into heats with other dogs of similar age.
8. Day-of registrations will be placed into heats on a first come, first serve basis.
9. Decisions of race judges are final.
